



## Building a Brighter Future.

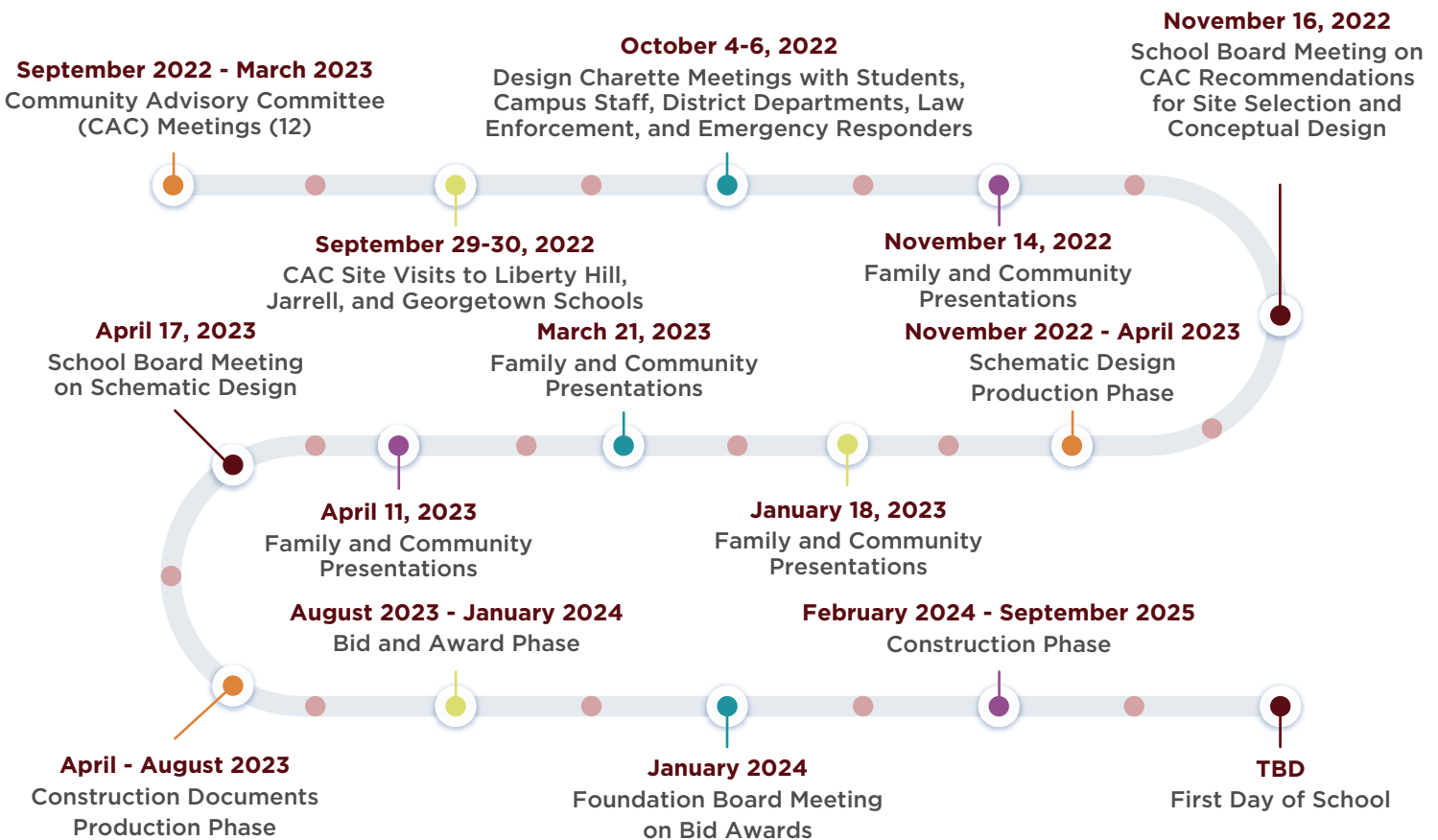

- 116,000 square feet
- 800 student capacity
- Two stories

- Multiple Flex Areas for Instructional Support
- A variety of play and recreational areas

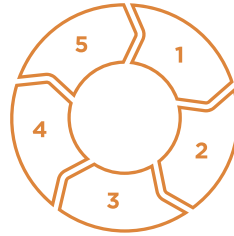

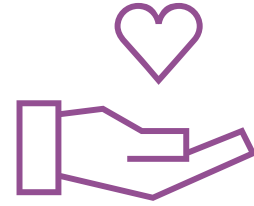
